**Annotated Transcript**

- I appreciate that you broke your transcript into sections. It was a great visual choice for your readers.
- Have you considered linking the actual courses? With the titles of the courses being green, it made me think they were interactive links.
- To make your transcript more interactive, you might also consider linking to some of the projects you talked about. For example, you wrote about the Dream IT assignment. Can you link to the paper you wrote for that? Or the blog posts you wrote about it? Or the project you created?
- You talked about all courses in past tense, except for the capstone. My suggestion is to put it in past tense to keep things consistent.
- I would also review the transcript for where you say “we” and “I” or “me,” as there is some inconsistency.
- Overall, I learned a lot about the classes you took and felt enlightened on the program.

**Showcase**

- You call the program “Masters in Education Technology Degree (MAET)” → It should be “Master of Arts in Education Technology Degree (MAET)”

- I like how you introduce the sections that this page is broken into. I noticed you capitalized the section titled Classroom Ideologies but not the section titled classroom abilities. I would suggest capitalizing both for consistency.
- 3X3X3 - What an awesome project! Can you link to that book? Perhaps the Amazon purchasing link or the author's page? Also, book titles should be underlined and all important words need capitalized: "Why don't students like school, by Daniel T. Willingham" should be [Why Don't Students Like School](#), by Daniel T. Willingham. (I linked the example!)
- Something to consider: some section titles are capitalized and some are not.
- Principle -> Principal
- I like that you have pictures.
- I LOVED that you linked to projects! I didn't know they were linked right away, as I just thought they were the titles and underlined for that reason. I would consider making mention of the fact there are links in your introduction section.
- The online classroom section still says work in progress (FYI).

### **Goals and Reflections**

- On the landing page for this section, the links are different colors and sizes. Perhaps make them the same and capitalize all of the words for consistency.
- Your Educational Goals essay was so touching. Your dad sounds like he was an amazing man!
